The “THARULJA” is a fictional country in ASEAN.

- ❑ Strong earthquake, measuring 9.0 on the Richter scale, with the center occurs in the THARULJA Sea, 4 km. deep, and close to the coastal cities.
- ❑ The tsunami strikes the cities on the coastline, resulting in rapid floods and collapsed buildings.
- ❑ A large number of casualties have been reported. Some have gone missing.
- ❑ Industrial factories within the area are damaged, causing chemical leaks.
- ❑ All communications are down.
- ❑ THARULJA reports the state of emergency to the AHA Centre and requests urgent medical assistance and HADR support

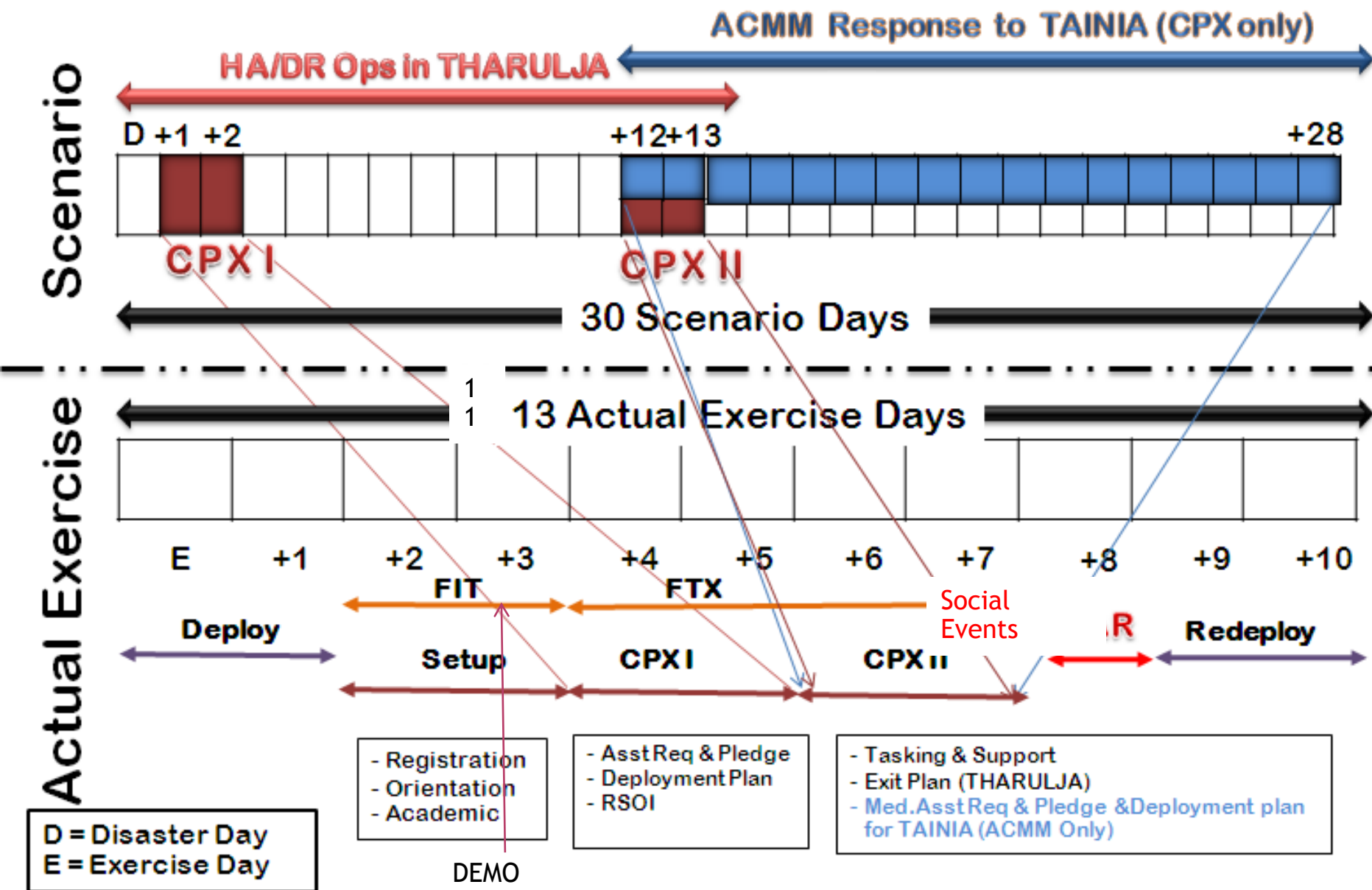


SCENARIO II(Dummy):Only for the operation area of ACMM

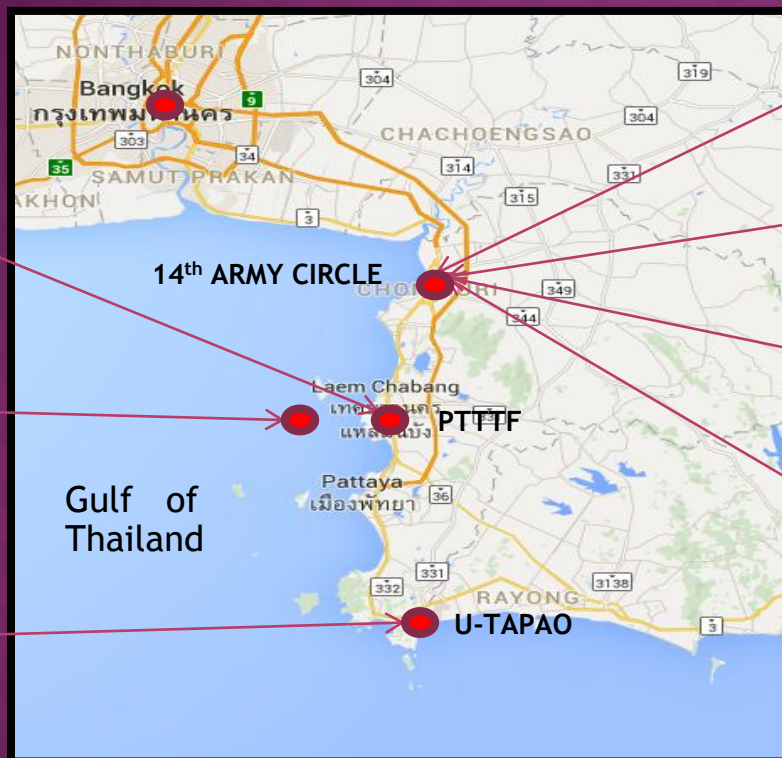

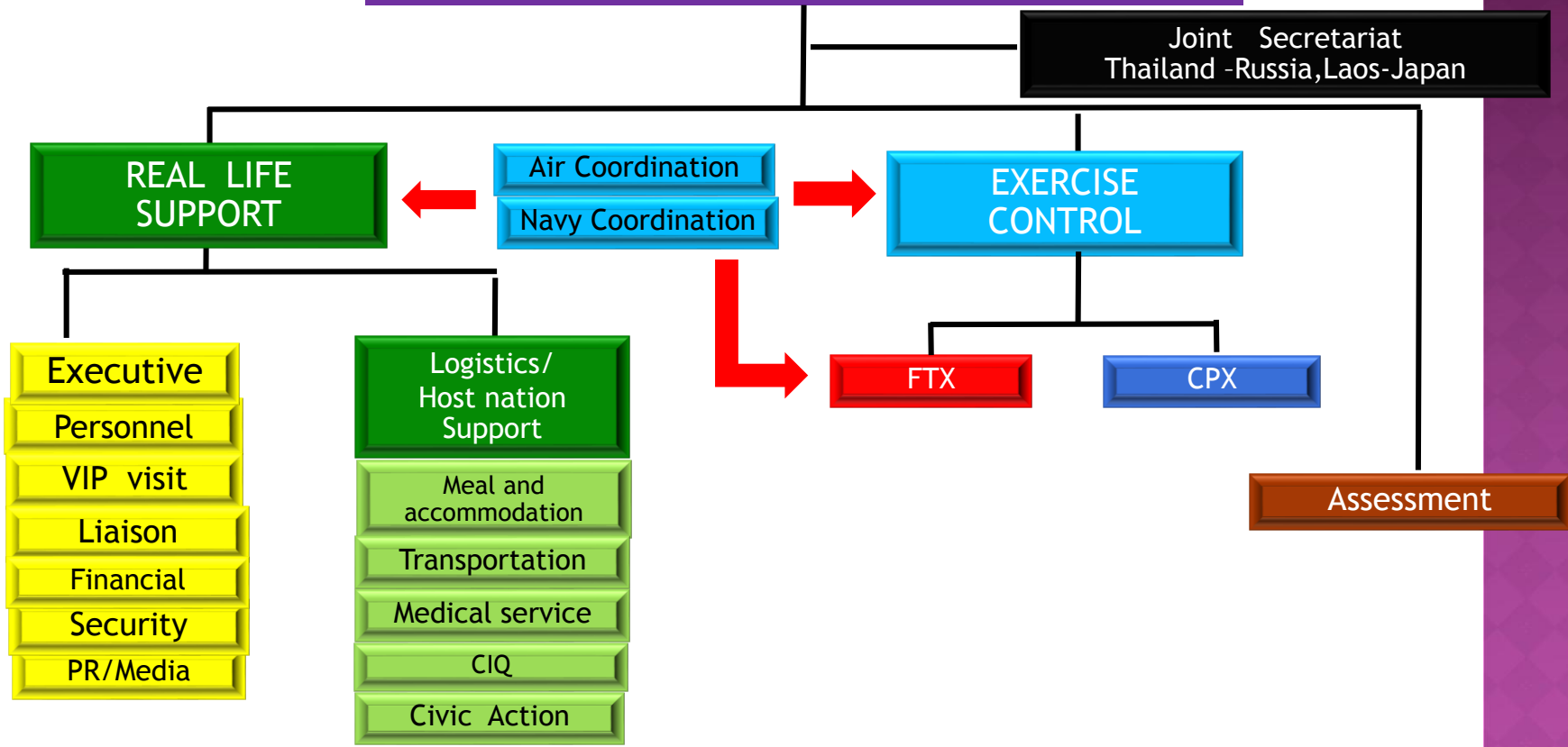

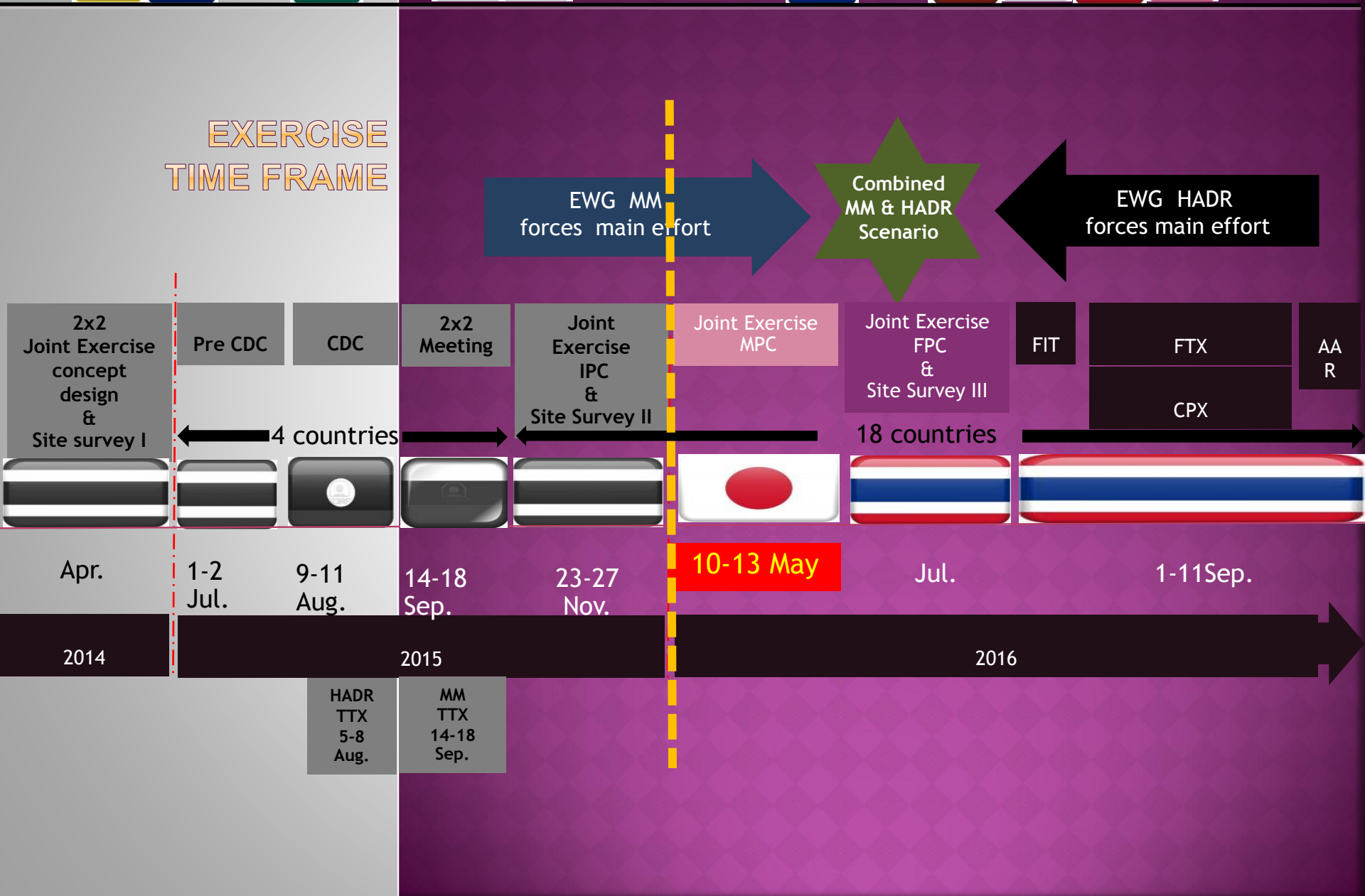
