




- Most of the countries faced difficulties in dealing with Nontraditional Security Threats.



were affected.








 Such Natural Disasters caused great socio- economic loss and damage Natural Resources.

- * Myanmar Navy rescued 1043 boat people in 2015.
- 777 people were officially verified as Bangladeshi citizens and sent home safely.
- Soat people were cared in temporary refugee camps and provided medical care, food, water and clothing.

- ✤ Search and rescue operations.
- Myanmar and Indonesia
 successfully cooperated in
 humanitarian task ; bringing
 back 535 Myanmar fishermen
 to Myanmar in May 2015.










- Signed AADMER on 26th July 2005 at Vientiane, Lao.

 and management.






Myanmar Defence Services attended as observer to HADR

 of modern high tech methods it
 would contribute much towards
 mitigating the damage and loss of
 life inflicted by natural disasters.







- ASEAN armed forces in drawing up and planning disaster preparedness and disaster management in cooperation.
- Early Warning System as well as a Monitoring System.
- Laying down the principles and guidelines for emergency response and for mitigation.
- Common plan for taking pre-emptive and preventive action and guidelines for systematic management in the aftermath of the disaster.












- Climate change and global warming is going to have a huge impact this year with the El Nino effect.

- El Nino will be experienced in the form of high temperatures, scarcity of drinking water, outbreak of fire, the drying up of rivers, creeks and lakes.
