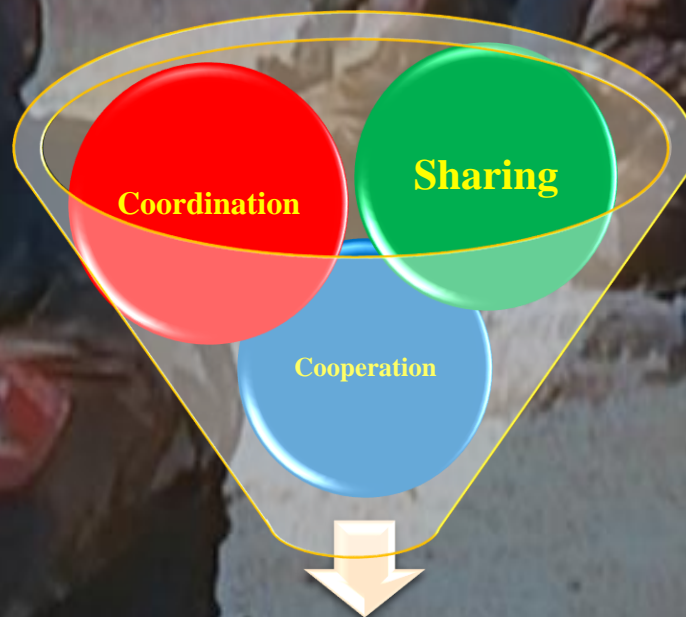

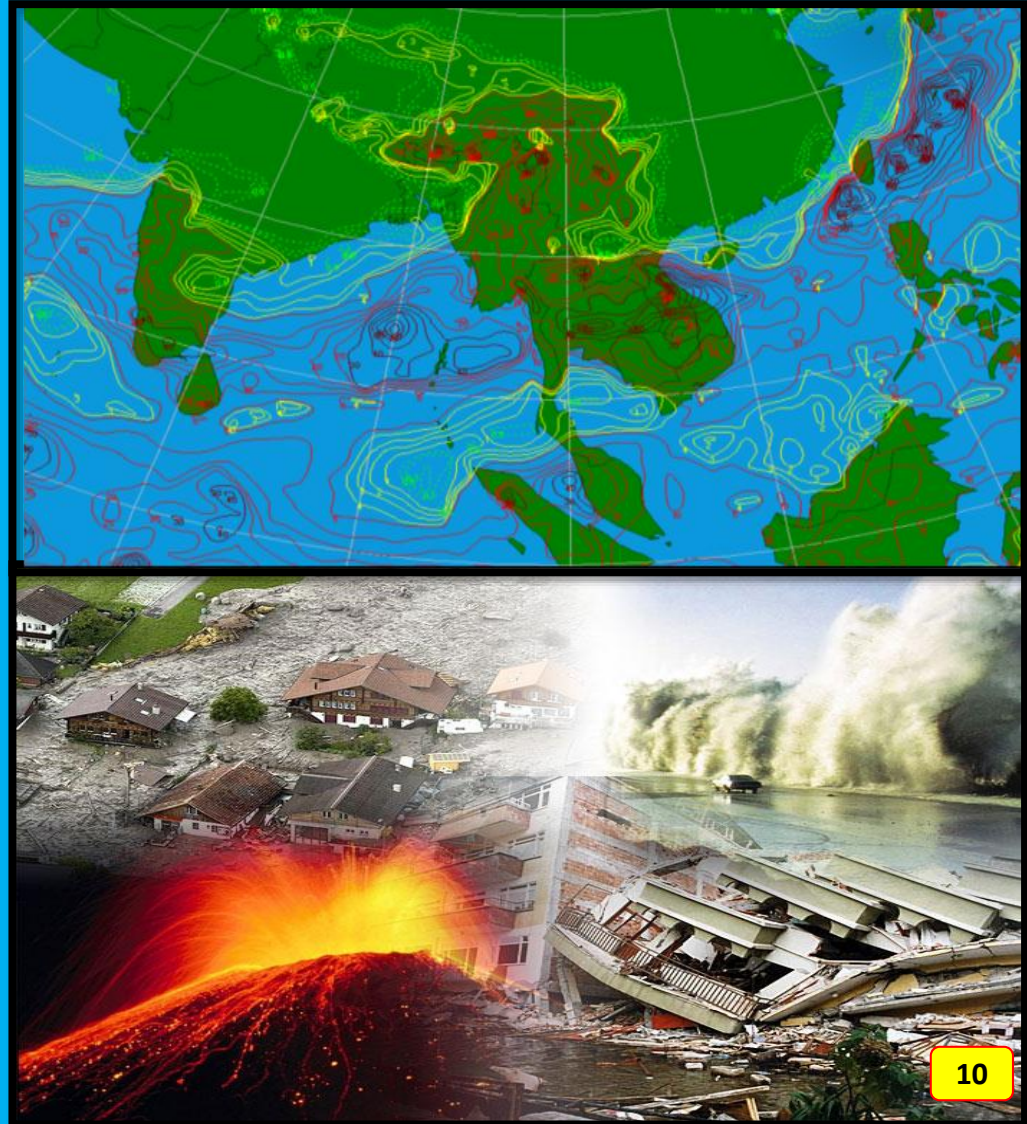

- ❖ The 2008 Constitution contains an article which stipulates that Myanmar Defence Services shall render assistance when calamities that affects the Union and its citizens occur in the Union.
- ❖ Myanmar Defence Services plays a principle role in times of emergency.

MYANMAR DEFENCE SERVICES



- ❖ Myanmar Navy rescued 1043 boat people in 2015.
- ❖ 777 people were officially verified as Bangladeshi citizens and sent home safely.
- ❖ Boat people were cared in temporary refugee camps and provided medical care, food, water and clothing.

MYANMAR DEFENCE SERVICES



- ❖ To prevent illegal immigrants and human trafficking.
- ❖ Search and rescue operations.
- ❖ Myanmar and Indonesia successfully cooperated in humanitarian task ; bringing back 535 Myanmar fishermen to Myanmar in May 2015.



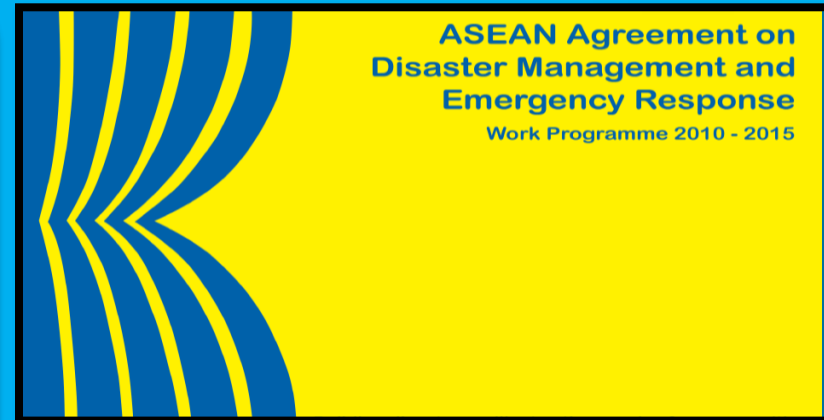

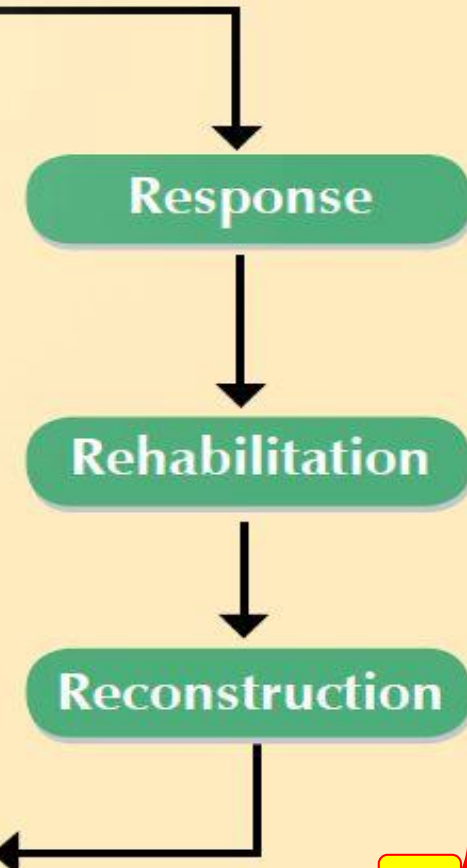

- ❖ Common plan for taking pre-emptive and preventive action and guidelines for systematic management in the aftermath of the disaster.



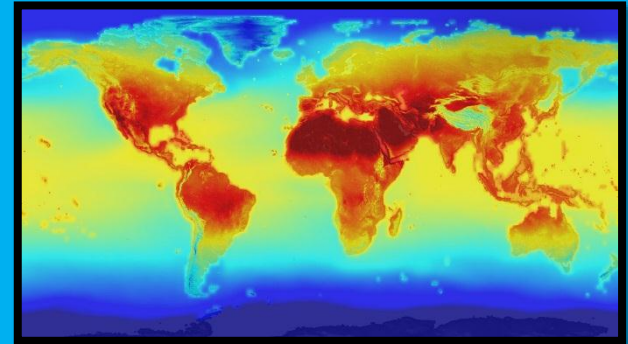

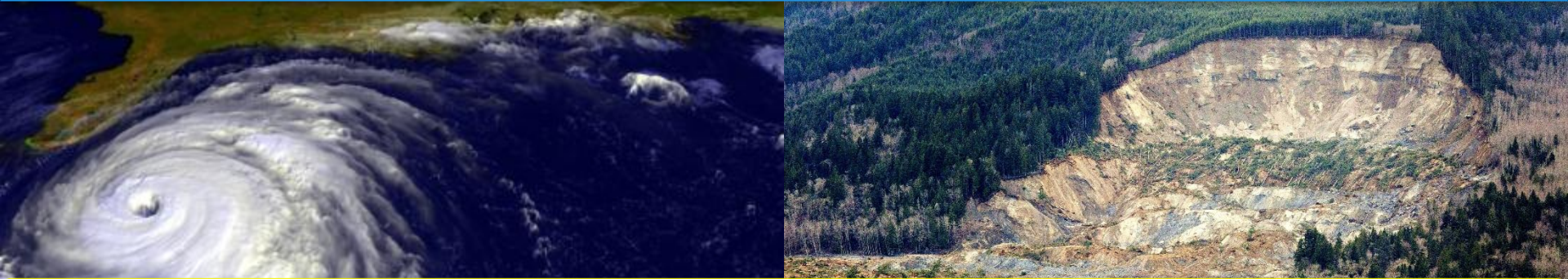
- ❖ ASEAN Armed Forces have to cooperate more closely both bilaterally and multilaterally to exchange and share important information to resolve these problems.
